**Theme and Topic:** Treaties - The Treaties in Saskatchewan - As Long as the Sun Shines

### Materials:

Construction paper	Felt
Buttons	Pipe Cleaners
Blue Yarn	Blue Feathers
Letters - Treaty #( ) whatever # treaty area they live in	

### Procedure:

1. Write the phrase: "As long as the sun shines, the grass grows and the rivers flow" on the board or on a flip chart.
2. Ask the students if they know about the treaties made between First Nations in what is now Saskatchewan and the British Crown. Discuss
3. Name the treaties made in what is now Saskatchewan 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10 by displaying the treaty map.
4. Have the students discuss what the phrase means: "As long as the sun shines, the grass grows and the rivers flow".
