Name of Make 'n Take: Location of First Nations Languages & Tribes

Theme and Topic: History – First Nations and Non-First Nations Peoples Benefit From Treaties

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Name of School: Albert - Regina Public School Division

Grade: 3

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Materials: Green felt or foam, black marker, colored beads, leather strips

OTC Map of “The First Nations of Saskatchewan (Language/Dialect Groups)”
OTC Map of “Treaty Boundaries, Location of First Nations and Treaty Sites in Saskatchewan”

Procedure:

1. Draw & cut out a Saskatchewan shape from green felt or foam.
2. Draw the 2, 4, 5, 6, 8, and 10 treaty boundaries.
3. Using colored beads, display the location of the First Nations language groups in Saskatchewan.
4. Label the location of Regina or of your home town or city.
5. Create a legend using beads, leather strips and foam.
6. Write the names of the language groups on the legend.
7. Discuss the First Nation languages primarily spoken near your city or town.

8. Discuss how there was a language barrier between First Nation groups and the newcomers at the signing of treaties.
